Lynn Broderick, founder and artistic director

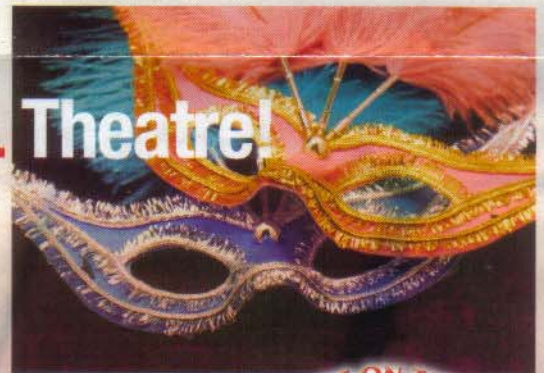
A native of Nebraska, Lynn completed her master's degree in theatre at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. Following graduation, Lynn and her young family moved to Columbia, Maryland, where she designed and performed professionally in the early '80s. Her theatrical association with Toby Orenstein of the Columbia Center for the Arts and owner and artistic director of Toby's Dinner Theatre gave her numerous opportunities to perform, teach, and develop programs and partnerships that integrated the professional theatre with the public school system. For nine years Lynn taught for the Howard County Public School System and was the author of four plays for The Labels Project. She has taught on the faculties of the University of Nebraska, Howard Community College, Mount Saint Mary's College and, most recently, Frostburg State University following her relocation to the western Maryland area in 1995.

Upon her arrival, Lynn began to develop the idea for a resident theatre company. She was the director of the Ecumenical Youth Ministry from 1996 to 2002. The ministry boasted a fifty-voice choir that performed and toured throughout the region. Since 1998, Lynn has been the director of the theatre program for the Preston County, West Virginia, Public Schools and the founder of the Preston County Summer Theatre and the Preston County Camp of the Arts. It is from these two venues that the current company of Theatre On The Lake emerged. Together with their mentor, the group of performers came together in the winter of 2006 with the dream of forming a summer theatre company in Garrett County. The company's "organic" style of producing theatre allows actors to be musicians, designers, technicians, and marketing/promotion personnel as well keeping the company small and very dedicated to its mission.

What the future holds for the company is dependent upon the generosity and support of the Garrett County community. In the not so distant future, Theatre On The Lake hopes to expand its programs to year-round, enabling even more of the community to engage in the powerful world of theatre through productions and academic programs.
